Volunteers, Lena and Caroline, traveled more than 200 miles round trip through a winter whiteout while providing transportation to a participant for surgery. They left early in the morning and traveled slowly and carefully, both saying prayers for safety throughout the trip.

Caroline recalls praying, "God, you're the driver and I'm just here to help." After dropping off the participant for her 4 hour surgery, our volunteers headed to breakfast. 
